Officer Reports:

Committee Reports:

Sunshine Committee: Six cards were sent last quarter, and 3 boxes of cards were ordered.

<u>Meal Coordinator</u>: A new chair for this committee was selected for the upcoming quarter. Directions for Serving Potlucks and Funerals were passed around.

Old Business:

<u>Project Kinship</u>: The church President was not in attendance, but had expressed an interest in sharing more information about Project Kinship with posters, a lock box, etc., for Mission Festival. All information was given to him about the Project. The Mary & Martha President will email him and see what he has in mind for projects. Mary & Martha ladies can offer to help if needed.

New Business:

<u>Kitchen Shower</u>: We should have the kitchen shower either in August or September. A quick inventory of the number of each item that is needed will be made and a donation list of items needed. It was suggested that in the future we make sure that one congregation doesn't end up hosting both Mission Festival and Reformation. Pastor will make sure the voters are aware of this.

<u>Ladies Outing</u>: It was suggested that the next outing be at Balistreri's Winery. This will be set up for the first Saturday in August. Maybe this can become a once-a-quarter event.

<u>Mission Festival</u>: The tentative date will be the last Sunday in September. It was suggested that the Cheyenne congregation be asked to bring desserts, Loveland congregation to bring salads and St. Paul will provide the main dish. Pastor will let the other congregations know what to bring.
