Today's Scriptures

First Lesson – James 3:13 – 4:6

Heavenly Versus Demonic Wisdom Pride Promotes Strife Humility Cures Worldliness

3:13 Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom. 14 But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. 15 This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. 16 For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there. 17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. 18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace. 4:1 Where do wars and fights come from among you? Do they not come from your desires for pleasure that war in your members? 2 You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and war. Yet you do not have because you do not ask. 3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures. 4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. 5 Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously"? 6 But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

Second Lesson – Mark 9:30-37

Jesus Again Predicts His Death and Resurrection / Who Is the Greatest?

30 Then they departed from there and passed through Galilee, and He did not want anyone to know it. 31 For He taught His disciples and said to them, "The Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of men, and they will kill Him. And after He is killed, He will rise the third day." 32 But they did not understand this saying, and were afraid to ask Him. 33 Then He came to Capernaum. And when He was in the house He asked them, "What was it you disputed among yourselves on the road?" 34 But they kept silent, for on the road they had disputed among themselves who would be the greatest. 35 And He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, "If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all." 36 Then He took a little child and set him in the midst of them. And when He had taken him in His arms, He said to them, 37 "Whoever receives one of these little children in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me, receives not Me but Him who sent Me."

Sermon Text – Jeremiah 11:18-20

Jeremiah's Life Threatened

18 Now the LORD gave me knowledge of it, and I know it; for You showed me their doings. 19 But I was like a docile lamb brought to the slaughter; and I did not know that they had devised schemes against me, saying, "Let us destroy the tree with its fruit, and let us cut him off from the land of the living, that his name may be remembered no more." 20 But, O LORD of hosts, You who judge righteously, Testing the mind and the heart, Let me see Your vengeance on them, For to You I have revealed my cause.

Daily Bible Readings for Home Devotions September 23-28

Mon Luke 10:38-42 While it was not wrong to be busy serving Jesus and His disciples, it should not distract us from the Word of God. "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God" (4:4).

Tues James 3:13-18 Those who have the wisdom that comes from above do things in wise humility. Envy and selfish ambition will not rule the day, but peacefulness, mercy, and good fruits.


Wed Proverbs 16:1-9 Verses 1 and 9 are the gate-posts of this wisdom from on high. People plan, but God establishes. "Commit what you do to the Lord, and your plans will be established" (v3).

Thurs Jeremiah 9:23-24 More valuable than human wisdom, strength, and riches is to know the Lord, "who shows mercy, justice, and righteousness on earth" (v24).

Fri 1 Corinthians 7:29-31 Wisdom from above teaches us to have a light grip on the things of this world, "for the way of life that belongs to this world is passing away" (v31). Give me Jesus!

Sat Philippians 3:8-14 Knowing Jesus is worth far more to the apostle than everything in the world. In connection with Jesus, Paul has the righteousness that comes from God by faith (v9). This brings the prize that has become his goal: the resurrection from the dead!
